

eligibility

Candidates must be U.S. citizens who, by July 1 of the year they enter the program, will have received at least a bachelor's degree and will not have reached their 30th birthday.

Those who already have significant experience in Asia or Asian studies are not eligible for the Luce Scholars Program.

Candidates may have taken Asian language or Asia-focused courses on a U.S. campus (without majoring in Asian Studies). They may have spent up to a total of eight weeks, or have participated in a university-organized summer program, in one or more countries where Luce Scholars are placed.

Luce Scholars have backgrounds in virtually every field other than Asian studies, including but not limited to the arts, journalism, law, medicine, science, public health, environmental studies, and international relations.
