Laboratory Safety Fundamental Concepts is for all students and employees working or conducting research in any laboratory environment at UCLA. This course is offered free of charge by Environment, Health and Safety. This online module provides an overview of laboratory safety requirements. Topics of discussion include: the recognition and mitigation of laboratory hazards; the use of engineering controls, administrative controls and personal protective equipment; working safely with chemicals, the use of MSDSs, procedures for disposing of hazardous chemical waste, and fire safety precautions for the laboratory.
