- Selected applicants will be issued an offer letter within two weeks of completing the selection process.

Students with a technical background are offered an opportunity to work on projects involving cutting-edge technologies in diverse areas such as distributed computing, machine learning, NLP, analytics, big data, statistics, knowledge engineering, legacy modernization, security, information management, data

privacy, cloud computing, testing, enterprise mobility, internet of things, open source, web services, android, mobile application development and artificial intelligence.
