

Hello,

I am a tenured professor in the Law School at UCLA, and I am looking to hire someone who can help me work with JSON files. I have been provided a large dataset about a topic of interest, and I need help accessing and organizing the data. My understanding is that we will need to write some scripts to amalgamate the JSON data into useful summary metrics, and some scripts just to unpack the data into more useful forms.

I am happy to hire someone by the hour, or on a project basis, and the data is available to be analyzed right now. I suspect that this would be a 40 hour project in the near term, with some additional short follow-up work later. This is then also a good opportunity to meet other professors at the Law School and possibly be offered other comparable data work.
