## Eligibility Criteria:

- Open to students of African American, Asian/Pacific Islander or Hispanic descent.
- Must show proof of U.S. citizenship or legal permanent residency with a permanent resident card or passport stamped I-551 (not expired).
- Have a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- Plan to attend a degree-seeking program, **full-time** at a U.S. accredited institution in the U.S., Puerto Rico, U.S. Virgin Islands or Guam during the 2012-2013 academic year.
- Will be entering sophomore, junior, senior or 5th-year senior year at an accredited college or university.
- Students of all majors will be considered.
- Preference will be given to students who demonstrate:
  - An interest in pursuing a career in the insurance and financial services industry
  - Leadership and participation in extracurricular activities.
- Must apply for federal financial aid by completing the **Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)** at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov).
