QUALIFICATIONS:

- You must be currently enrolled as a full-time student in an accredited civil engineering or city/urban planning undergraduate or graduate degree program at the time of filing. An applicant can be employed up to six (6) months after graduation; otherwise, you must be either returning to an undergraduate program or entering into a graduate program in Fall 2011.
- You must be considering a career in transportation/traffic engineering or planning. Completion of one or more transportation engineering or planning course(s) is desirable but not required.
- You must be a US Citizen, green card holder, or have a legal work permit prior to application.
