Sandia National Labs is seeking extraordinary applicants for two prestigious postdoctoral opportunities supporting our national security mission. Applications for employment will be accepted for the Truman Fellowship and the new Jill Hruby Fellowship through November 1, 2017. All qualified applicants are encouraged to apply at sandia.gov/careers; search for job number 657429 (Truman Fellowship) or 658086 (Hruby Fellowship).

Appointments will commence Fall 2018. Sandia offers an annual salary of \$111,200 and competitive benefits for these special fellowships.

In particular we wish to draw your attention to the new [Hruby Fellowship](#), named after Sandia Labs' immediate past director, Jill Hruby. This fellowship is designed to attract and recruit talented women in engineering and science fields who are interested in becoming technical leaders in national security. The Jill Hruby Fellowship Program will immerse postdoctoral candidates in a three year technical leadership development program, including mentoring by executives and exposure to national security policy. The Program will help prepare fellows to lead technical areas at Sandia, other national laboratories and national security organizations. It complements the existing Sandia Truman Fellowship for researchers in relevant science and engineering fields.
