UCCONNECT Summer Research Program at Cal Poly Pomona

The summer program seeks to attract both undergraduate and graduate students (specially those from under-represented demographics) with interests in transportation research to directly collaborate with faculty members in the completion of an independent study. The final goal of the program is the creation of opportunities to prepare Region 9 students in their transition from academia to industry practice and to incentivate students to choose transportation as their specialty field to pursue graduate-level studies.

Prospective Students

The program is open to both undergraduate and graduate students, but undergraduate students will be given priority. Participating students from universities in Region 9 will work on an independent study together with a supervising faculty member. Students are expected to work on their projects individually unless they get direct approval from the program director, Dr. Wen Cheng. **Each participating students will receive a \$3000 scholarship**. In addition, a certificate will be presented for the completion of the Summer Program during a final Symposium.

The students will be expected to prepare either a report or manuscript for potential publication. All participating students will also be required to do a presentation and submit a report to the Program Director. To complete the program students will have to be at CPP's campus during the first week of the program and the for the final Symposium day.
